# GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## ENTRY FORM

### EXHIBITOR

- The exhibition is open to all artists, and submissions are welcome particularly from past and present members of the M.R.S.S. community - senior students, parents, teachers and friends.
- Work offered for exhibition must be signed on the front of the artwork by the artist or appropriately labelled in the case of three dimensional works.
- The artist must supply an artist's profile with the work.

### CRITERIA AND CONDITIONS FOR SELECTED WORKS

- Work must be **original and recent** of the artist.
- Work must remain on show for the duration of the exhibition.
- Work must be available for sale.
- Work must not have been exhibited at the MRSS Art Exhibition and Sale in previous years.
- The exhibition is open to two-dimensional works in any medium, including watercolour, acrylic, oils, drawings, printmaking, photography and collage.
- The exhibition is open to three-dimensional works including ceramics, textiles, glass, jewelry and sculpture.
- Each artist can submit up to three works.

### ENTRY FEES

- The entry fee of \$7 per exhibit must be posted with the entry form. Cheques should be made payable to the Melbourne Rudolf Steiner School S.C.A.
- The entry fee for any work entered but not displayed will be refunded.

### PRICES

- The school will not be responsible for any difference in the price shown on the entry form and a price shown elsewhere on an artwork.
- If there is a difference between the price shown on the entry form and a price shown elsewhere on the exhibit, the work may be sold at lower price.
- All pricing should be GST inclusive.

### COMMISSION

- There is a 25% commission on all sales to go directly to the Melbourne Rudolf Steiner School S.C.A.

### DISPLAY

- Artwork for exhibition must be ready for hanging, with 'D' rings affixed approximately one third from the top of the frame and with hanging wire reaching not higher than 80 millimeters below the top on the frame.
- Artwork offered for exhibition **must have the artist's name, title of the artwork, the medium and price marked clearly** on a label affixed to the back of the work or where appropriate for three-dimensional work.
- Works offered for exhibition should be listed in order of preference for display. If space is exhausted, the available space will be afforded to works from the order of preference as specified on the entry form.
- It is the responsibility of the artist to ensure all work offered for exhibition meets all conditions of entry.
- The Exhibition Committee reserves the right not to exhibit any work that it deems inappropriate.

### DELIVERY AND COLLECTION

- All works to be delivered to the gymnasium between 5.00pm and 8.30pm, Thursday, March 11th.
- All work to be collected from the gymnasium between 4.00pm and 6.00pm, Sunday, March 14th.
- Any works not collected by the time advised will be disposed of at the discretion of the exhibition committee.
- Neither the committee or any member of the committee or Melbourne Rudolf Steiner School will be responsible for works not collected by this time.

### CAVEAT

- The Melbourne Rudolf Steiner School and the Exhibition Committee will exercise all reasonable care, but will accept no responsibility for any loss, theft or damage of artworks offered for exhibition.
