- Eco, organic, or sustainable

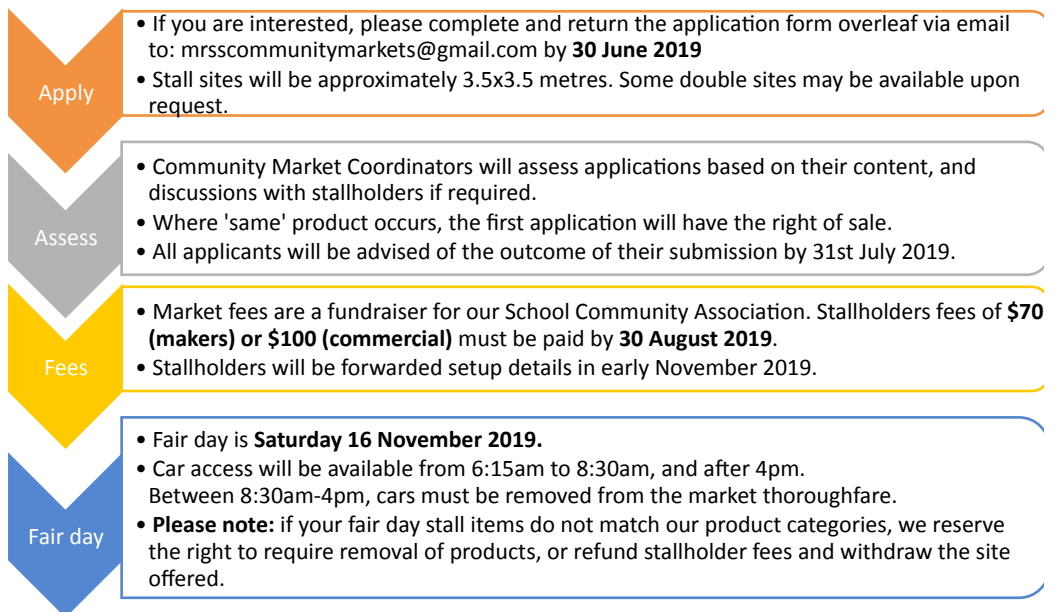
Products sold through Direct Selling schemes or similar are not considered appropriate.
